ANNOUNCEMENT

To facilitate and manage smooth visits to Paro Taktsang by all visitors, the Dratshang Lhentshog is implementing the following with effect from **1st March 2017**.

- Taktsang monastery will remain open from 8 a.m. till 4 p.m. There will be no lunch break in between.
- All non-Bhutanese visitors will receive guided tours of the monastery.
- There will be an entry fee of Nu. 500 per person for all non-Bhutanese visitors (except those paying the government prescribed minimum daily package rate)
- The entry fee for students (upon production of student id) will be Nu. 250 per person
- Guided tours for groups (except those paying the government prescribed minimum daily package rate) will start from the viewpoint area.
- Entry tickets can be purchased from the ticket counter located at Ramthangkha (near the parking lot and restroom)
- Guides for tourists paying the daily minimum package rate should take either an electronic or print copy of the visas of their guests.

We are also working on improving the facilities both at the monastery site and the route with the relevant agencies. Therefore, we would like to request everyone to cooperate so that together we can make the visit to Paro Taktsang a memorable experience for all.
