Terms and Conditions for the sale

1. The selling price of the stamp book will be determined by TCB and the commission of 20% on the SP shall be allowed.
2. The firms will be required to pay 50% of the selling price of the stamp books of the specified quantity in cash and the remaining half payment shall be made after the successful sale of the stamp books. If the bidders fail to make remaining payments of the sold booklet, it will be dealt as per the Royal Court of Justice and the firm shall be barred from participating in any future procurement works under TCB. The amount will be recovered from initial advances, if adequate.
3. The firm shall deposit the payment every month after sale of Druk Neykor Stamp Book.
4. In the event where the firms are unable to the sell the stamp books, the return to TCB is allowed with the condition that the stamp books should be in the same condition as it was during the issuance of the books. In such case, the initial advances of the returned books will be paid back to the firms.

5. In the event where TCB receives any complaints from the buyers on the unreasonable price of the items sold, the firms shall surrender all the remaining books and the selling prices, i.e., 50% of the sold stamp books. In addition, the initial 50% of the amount paid to the TCB shall also be withheld. More importantly, the firm shall be barred from participating in any future procurement works under TCB.
6. Separate agreement will be signed with the selected firms.
7. The bidder shall collect the Stamp Books from Tourism Council of Bhutan, Chubachu, Thimphu at their own cost.
8. The bidder is encouraged to enquire the focal and inspect the samples of Druk Neykor Stamp Book from TCB.
9. If there arise multiple selected bidders, the quantities of distribution will be determined based on the maximum copies available upon consultation with the selected bidders.
