### NOTIFICATION

This is to notify that the preferential Sustainable Development Fee (SDF) of Nu.1200 for nationals of India visiting Bhutan as tourist, which was introduced under the Tourism Levy Act of Bhutan 2020, will remain in effect for two years from the date of enactment of the Tourism Levy Act of Bhutan 2022.

This is in consideration that the SDF rate for above could not be implemented due to the closing down of tourism following the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic. After observing the implementation of this SDF for two years, it may be reviewed and revised in keeping with the principle of the preferential rate on the SDF for above nationals.

This Notification is issued in accordance with Section 9 (4) of Chapter 2 of the Tourism Levy Act of Bhutan 2022.
